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QUESTIONS & ANSWERS ABOUT THE ORTHOCARE PROGRAM

1. I LIKE MY CURRENT FAMILY DENTIST. DO I HAVE TO SELECT A NEW GENERAL DENTIST?

No, you do not need to change general dentists. You can continue to see your general dentist. When you join the OrthoCare program, you select an Orthodontic specialist from the list of OrthoCare providers.

2. DO ALL FAMILY MEMBERS NEED TO GO TO THE SAME ORTHOCARE PROVIDER?

Family members can choose their own OrthoCare Provider.

3. IS THE ORTHOCARE PROGRAM AN INSURANCE PRODUCT?

No, the OrthoCare program is a reduced fee program in which the OrthoCare providers have agreed to provide orthodontic services to OrthoCare members for a reduced fee. This results in meaningful member savings in comparison to the normal (UCR) fees typically charged by orthodontists.

4. DO I NEED TO REMAIN A MEMBER DURING MY ORTHODONTIC TREATMENT?

Yes, you must continue to be a member of the OrthoCare program throughout your entire orthodontic treatment to receive the reduced fees for services provided by the OrthoCare provider.

5. TO WHAT AGE ARE CHILDREN INCLUDED?

Children who are dependents are able to receive discounted services under the family program until age 19, or to age 23 if they are a full time student.

6. I AM CURRENTLY HAVING ORTHODONTIC TREATMENT DONE, CAN I BENEFIT FROM THE ORTHOCARE PROGRAM?

No, the OrthoCare program would not be a benefit to you if you are currently receiving orthodontic treatment.
